To Levin late 1914
Rangitikei Advocate 28 Dec 1914 – “Arrived Levin a few weeks ago from Palmerston Nth. Taking photo near library, stepped back over bank on edge of gravel pit, 9 or 10 ft fall, broke leg.”

To Taihape – Taihape Daily Times advertisement 4 Dec 1915 (at least until 1920)

15 Oct 1915
A fire broke out in Pringle & haste’s building in Oxford St, Levin. The building was occupied by S Ladelle, photographer & R E Lucas, Bookseller & stationer. The building & contents were completely destroyed.

Was a volunteer in 44th Middlesex Rifle Corp

Indentured to Merchant Nay in Aug 1875 at age 16. This was cancelled in May 1876

In 1881 census was a lodger in Wraysburg. Described as a Bank clerk (general)
